DO YOU OWN A DOG?



THE DEADLINE TO
PURCHASE YOUR DOG
TAG WAS MAY 1ST. A
reminder that failure to
purchase a dog tag could
result in a fine of \$150.
Tags purchased after May

1st will result in a late fee of \$15 each and if
left unpaid after August 1, an additional cost
of \$10 each + your outstanding invoice will be
added to your final tax bill.

It is your responsibility to register your dog's
information with Township staff.

Note: Residents are required to control their dogs and ensure they do not leave their
property unless on a leash. Owners of dogs found running at large, can face a fine of \$150.
Also, failure to remove your dog's waste, or failure to purchase a dog tag can receive the same
fine.

2020 RABIES CLINIC

Purchasing 2020 Dog Tags

Dog tags can still be purchased by mailing, or by dropping your fees off in the drop box located outside
the office. Receipts and tags will be mailed to you once your fees have been received.

2020 DOG TAG FEES

Spayed or Neutered Dog
\$20.00

Each Additional Spayed or Neutered
\$30.00

Each Dog (Unspayed or Unneutered)
\$30.00

Each Additional Dog (Unspayed or
Unneutered) \$40.00

Proof of spaying/neutering is
required. Also, proof of rabies
vaccination must be provided when
purchasing a dog licence.

**For the safety of your dog and the
benefit of your neighbours, please:**



1. **Don't let your dog run at large.** Dog owners need to respect other people's property by ensuring their dogs stay on their own land. The Township's Animal Control Officer is authorized to pick up dogs running at large and the dog's owner will be responsible to pay the cost of releasing the animal from the pound and may be subject to a fine of \$150.

2. Dogs are prohibited from creating a noise disturbance in the neighbourhood!



3. **License your dog** with the Township by May 1st every year. Licensed dogs can be identified and returned to their owner, if lost.



4. Owners are responsible to pick up their dog waste - "**stoop and scoop**". We need your help to keep our environment clean!

5. **Vaccinate your dog** yearly against rabies. Proof of vaccination will be required when purchasing your dog tag. All dogs aged 3 months and older, must be vaccinated.

6. No owner or household shall possess more than **three (3) dogs** at any time.

7. Failure to purchase a dog tag could result in a fine of \$150.
