Re: DWQMS Water Distribution Management Review

Paul Dalton, Overall Responsible Operator for the Township's water distribution system presented the Annual 2020 DWQMS Management Report to Council. Mr. Dalton chaired the DWQMS Management Review Meeting with respect to the Water Distribution System. Topics of discussion included: Incidents of Regulatory Non-Compliance, Incidents of Adverse Drinking Water Tests; Deviations from Critical Control Point Limits and Corrective Actions; Efficacy of the Risk Assessment Process; Internal and 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Audits; Emergency Response Testing; Operational Performance; Actions of Previous Management Reviews; Status of Management Action Items; Changes in Resource Requirements; Consumer Feedback; Maintenance of QMS; Infrastructure Review; Status of Operational Plan; Staff Suggestions; and New Business Items from Council.
