Steven Jelich and Darryl Arnold presented an update on the London Line Replacement Project for Enbridge Gas Inc. A presentation was made to update Council on the Enbridge 2021 London Lines Replacement project, which will replace the existing two (2) London Line pipelines to improve the integrity of pipeline network, increase system flexibility and ensure adequate supply to the area. The majority of the existing London Lines were installed between 1930's to 1950's, and will be replaced with one (1) new, 82km pipeline, combination of 4 and 6 inches in diameter, installed at higher pressure. The project has been approved by the Ontario Energy Board with an Environmental report completed. Customers already connected to the existing London Lines will not be affected, and the project will open approximately 5 properties not currently connected due to route changes. Anticipated construction timeline is Spring 2021 – December 2021, with project clean-up and restoration to occur in 2022. The Mayor thanked Enbridge Gas Inc. for their informative presentation.

Jay Lewis, Real Estate & Municipal Affairs, FB Connect attended as a follow-up to the Preliminary Information Package dated January 13, 2021 regarding a proposed 45m Lite-Duty Support Lattice Communications Tower to be located west of 3889 Bentpath Line, which would provide wireless internet services to Xplornet customers in the community. Public notices were sent to surrounding properties

within 135m of the proposed telecommunication structure and was published in the Independent News on January 21, 2021, with a deadline to comment of February 22, 2021. No submissions or request for a meeting during the public consultation process were received. The County of Lambton Planner, Ezio Nadalin, provided a report regarding the proposed telecommunications tower, indicating that the telecommunications project is permitted as proposed, subject to any prescribed Ontario Building Code requirements, and that the chosen site appears to be appropriate for the proposed site.
