# dogs in kennel \_\_\_\_\_

Information:

1. A Kennel is defined as any building, pen or other structure, but not including a building used for human habitation, in which a dog or dogs are kept, whether or not for breeding or boarding and in respect of which the owner has or is eligible to have issued by the Municipality, a kennel license pursuant to the regulations.
2. No person shall keep a dog kennel without a license.
3. All dog kennels license applications shall provide a sufficiently detailed site plan to determine the kennel building or buildings.
4. Every owner of a kennel shall pay to the Township a kennel license fee for each year pursuant to the Fees for Services By-law, as amended from time to time.
5. Every kennel shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition and free of refuse of any kind at all times so as to prevent the arising of odours there from, and shall be kept free of flies or vermin at all times.
6. No kennel may be established except where it is permitted under the applicable zoning by-law.
7. All kennels may be subject to inspection by the Medical Officer of Health for the Township of Dawn-Euphemia or his / her designate, as, in his /her discretion, he/she feels it is warranted and where, in his /her opinion, a kennel deviates from the minimum standards established by him / her, the Township shall be at liberty to revoke the license herein granted until such time as the Township is notified by the Medical Officer of Health that the Kennel complies with these standards. The owner of the kennel shall have a right to appeal to Council the revocation in this regard.
8. A minimum separation of 250 metres shall be maintained between Kennels and between Kennels and adjacent Residential, Open Space and Institutional Uses.
9. Kennel licenses must be purchased annually at the Township municipal office (4591 Lambton Line, RR 4 Dresden, ON N0P 1M0).
10. A copy of the current rabies vaccination certificate must be presented for each dog at the time of purchasing the kennel license.
11. If the tenant of the land is the one interested in the kennel license, they must have a letter of authorization from the owner permitting the kennel on their property.
