2023 Dog Tag Invoices

Your 2023 Dog Tag is enclosed with your invoice.
Please remit payment to the Township of Dawn-Euphemia
by May 1, 2023.



NEW DOG TAG RATES FOR 2023:



- \$40 - each male/female dog
- \$50 - each additional male/female dog
- \$30 - spayed/neutered dog
- \$40 - each additional spayed/neutered dog
- \$135 - kennel
- \$15 - replace lost dog tag
- \$15 - dog attaining age of 3 months after May 01
- \$15 - newcomers to the Township after May 01
- \$20 - penalty for late tag purchase
- \$10 - admin fee if dog tag fee is added to collectors roll

Tags purchased after May 1st will result in a late fee of \$20 each and if left unpaid by August, an additional cost of \$10 each + your outstanding invoice will be added to your final tax bill.

Acceptable Methods of payment

New! Dog tags can now be paid online as a bill payment by selecting The Township of Dawn-Euphemia – Animal License and using your invoice number as an account number through your financial institution, or at the municipal office by cheque, cash, debit or by dropping your payment off in the after-hours drop box located to the left of the main office door. The drop box is checked regularly throughout the day. Our office hours are Monday – Friday 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

It is your responsibility to register your dog's information with Township staff. Please contact the Township Office at 519-692-5148 if the information provided is incorrect.

IF YOUR DOG PASSES away during the year, please advise Township Staff so that your dog tag records can be amended.





Note: Residents are required to control their dogs and ensure they do not leave their property unless on a leash. Owners of dogs found running at large, can face a fine of \$150. The Township's Animal Control Office is authorized to pick up dogs running at large and bring them to the Sarnia & District Humane Society. The dog's owner will be required to show proof of dog tags purchased and pay all associated fees before the dog is released from the Sarnia & Distract Humane Society.

Failure to remove your dog's waste, or failure to purchase a dog tag can receive the same fine.

Please ensure when attending the Rabies clinic your dogs are leashed and cats contained.



Tips for Preventing Rabies

- ✓ Ensure dogs and cats are up to date on their rabies vaccinations.
- ✓ Keep your pets under control. Don't let them run free or unsupervised.
- ✓ Don't approach or attempt to pet or capture wild animals.
- ✓ Stay away from animals that look sick, and don't touch dead animals.
- ✓ Report all wildlife (e.g. raccoons, skunks, foxes etc.) exhibiting abnormal behaviour to the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry rabies hotline at 1-888-574-6656.
- ✓ Report all animal bites or other potential rabies exposures to humans to Lambton Public Health by calling 519-383-8331 or 1-800-667-1839.
- ✓ Report all domestic pets exposed to potentially rabid animals to your local vet and/or to Ontario Ministry of Food and Rural Affairs at 1-877-424-1300.
- ✓ If you've been bitten or scratched by an animal, wash the wound with soap and hot water and contact your family doctor.
- ✓ Report all biting incidents to Lambton Public Health.
