DOG TAG RATES FOR 2024:



\$50 - each additional male/female dog

\$30 - spayed/neutered dog

\$40 - each additional spayed/neutered dog

\$135 - kennel

\$15 - replace lost dog tag

\$15 - dog attaining age of 3 months after May 01

\$15 - newcomers to the Township after May 01

\$20 - penalty for late tag purchase

\$10 - admin fee if dog tag fee is added to collectors roll

Tags purchased after May 1st will result in a late fee of \$20 each and if left unpaid by August, an additional cost of \$10 each + your outstanding invoice will be added to your final tax bill.
