As part of Lambton County's 175<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebrations, Lambton County Library and Lambton County Museums are partnering to offer Lambton's residents a chance to share their local historical artifacts, photographs, documents, or diaries by participating in a **Show and Tell** where they can show and tell us about their item. Cultural Services staff will then scan or photograph the item (when possible) so it can be digitized and preserved for generations to come.

Lambton 175 Show & Tell events will be held at 12 locations, with a "Best of Show & Tell" event to wrap-up the initiative and show the community the most interesting discoveries uncovered at the 12 events. The following table outlines the Lambton 175 Show & Tell event details:

It is hoped that these Show & Tell events will create opportunities for community members to share local historical information and demonstrate the importance of preserving local history for future generations. Any of the following types of artifacts, documents or photographs would be ideal candidates for a Show & Tell event: family portraits, photos featuring local landscapes or people, land records or legal documents, diaries, items used by or advertising local businesses or the local agriculture industry, local memorabilia or uniforms, items made by local businesses etc. (Firearms or any other explosive materials can not be included as a Show and Tell item.)
