

Month of June

• The Public Works Department is planning to commence the operations, as were previously planned, by mid June. We have been inundated with rainfall for the last more than two weeks, (as much as seven inches,) and will need for the groundwater levels to decrease, prior to any excavation. We anticipate dedicating a crew to install the Testing Sites, then to conduct testing, to remain dedicated to this project, until completed.


The amount Bid, is very close to the amount which I had included for budgetting purposes, thus, with no unforssen costs, the Project should be within the total amount budgetted.

Background:

A Report to recommend a contractor to supply and install a new steel roof on the Pavilion at the Florence Community Centre Grounds.

Comments:

I wish to utilize local Contractor Nth Degree Construction Inc. to supply and install the new steel roof at the pavilion at the Florence Community Centre Grounds. Nth Degree was the successful Bidder for the roof at the Shetland Park Pavillion, being less than half of the next highest Quote. The price is also, only slightly higher, but is practically the same, based on square footage.

Consultations:

Cornellius Unger of Nth Degree Construction Inc. was consulted.

Financial Implications:

\$5,460 + taxes.

The amount quoted is less than the amount budgeted in the 2024 Budget (\$7,500).

OPEN SESSION REPORT FIN 24-06-03

Background:

In the most recent annual Audit, the Auditors advised that Dawn Euphemia has surpassed the HST tax remittance threshold of \$50,000 established by the CRA.

Comments:

Council has two options to proceed with HST going forward in regards to the Fees bylaw:

- 1) In our discussions with other Municipalities, it is standard practice in the area to keep the fees the same as they are, but to have the total cost include an HST portion as well. For example, where currently we are charging \$60 for a tax certificate, we would now propose charging \$53.10 + \$6.90 HST = \$60. Therefore, the total fees collected remains the same, but a portion of the fees collected would now go to the CRA in the HST remittance.
- 2) The other method would be to keep the fees schedule the same but now include HST on top of the charge. For example, a tax certificate would now be \$60 + \$7.80 HST = \$67.80; we do not recommend this method as we have already set our fees for the year plus it may cause confusion based on previous standards.

Financial:

We are trying to get in contact with the CRA to determine the start date of the HST remittance but the initial estimate Dawn Euphemia would need to pay for back HST taxes outstanding is approximately \$15,000. We will also need to ask CRA which accounts would be affected by HST remittance.

Consultations:

We have been in consultation with the auditors and the CRA regarding HST tax remittance, including the time period the remittance starts as well as which line items qualify for tax remittance.

Recommendation:

That Council implement option 1) adjust the fees schedule to include HST. That Council keep the current fees totals charges to clients but include HST as part of the charge collected from clients.

<u>#24:</u> Bradley/Loosley:

- a) That provided the funding stipulated in paragraph b) below is secured, that the County of Lambton engage a third-party consultant to carry out a Demand and Feasibility Study on the need for, and options for, a rural/inter-community transit system.
- b) That the County be authorized to expend up to \$150,000 (including H.S.T.) to engage the third-party consultant for the purposes stated in paragraph (a) above, provided that the County first secure no less than \$50,000 in funding through external, thirdparty funding sources.
- c) That Staff return to Council in September 2024 with an update on items (a) and (b) above.
