Election Day is October 26, 2026

The Township of Dawn-Euphemia will be using the VOTE-BY-MAIL method of voting again for this year’s Municipal Election. Instead of traveling to a polling station on Election Day, the ballot box will be brought to your mail box.



With Vote-By-Mail, voters can fill out their ballots in the privacy and convenience of their own home. Casting a vote is as easy as mailing a letter!

Voters will receive a Voter Kit in the mail at the end of September containing all of the materials required to vote by mail. The voter simply follows the instructions in their kit, deposits their ballot in the mail using the postage paid response envelope, and the ballots will be delivered to the Municipal Office for counting on Election Day.

If you choose not to mail your vote, you can still drop-off your ballot at the Municipal Office in Rutherford during regular business hours or in the after hours drop box.
