Wheels & Wells Car Show Returns to the Oil Museum of Canada on August 22
Thursday, July 30, 2026

Oil Springs, ON – Classic cars, unique vehicles and local oil history will come together at the Oil Museum of Canada, National Historic Site, for the second annual Wheels & Wells Car Show on Saturday, August 22 from 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Open to all makes and models, the event will bring vehicles from across the region to the historic Oil Springs site for an afternoon of automotive displays, museum activities and family-friendly fun. Vehicle registration begins at 9:30 a.m. by donation, with a suggested contribution of \$10 per vehicle appreciated. The event officially begins at 11:00 a.m. with free admission for event spectators.

The Wheels & Wells Car Show aims to highlight a wide range of vehicles. Visitor and participant-voted awards will be presented to outstanding entries. Special activities throughout the day will include a display of oil and automotive-related artifacts from the museum collection, oil history trivia contests for prizes and a 50/50 lottery draw. The event celebrates the connection between transportation and the oil history preserved at the Oil Museum of Canada.
