VOTE-BY-MAIL



Election Day is MONDAY OCTOBER 26!
This year, is the Municipal Elections! In Dawn-Euphemia we will be using the Vote-By-Mail option where voters will receive their ballots in the mail. The voter simply follows the instructions in their kit, deposits their ballot in the mail, using the postage paid return envelope, and the ballots will be delivered to the Municipal Office for counting on Election Day.

What if I don't receive a voting kit?

If you have not received a voting package by the first week of October, you will need to **pick one up at the Municipal Office**.

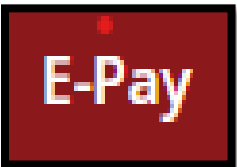

The Township of Dawn-Euphemia is now offering 2 new, convenient services to our residents. The first is e-billing (receiving your tax & water bills electronically) and the second is e-Pay (the ability to pay invoices online by credit card/PayPal).

With e-Billing, you will receive an email notification from the Township as soon as your bill becomes available. You can also view your bills at any time by logging in through the Township’s website www.dawneuphemia.ca. By using the e-Pay service, payments can be made securely online using a credit card or PayPal.

REGISTRATION IS QUICK & EASY:



Visit www.dawneuphemia.ca (homepage-top right) to locate the E-Pay button to Register. You will need to Create an Account. You will need to know your Roll # and PIN # for Tax Bill Registration and your Account # and PIN # for Water Bill Registration.

How to pay your bills online with e-Pay

- 1. You can choose to sign up for e-Billing, e-Pay, or both — it’s entirely up to you! E-Billing lets you receive your Water and Tax Bills (including Supplementals) electronically, while e-Pay allows you to pay any invoices you receive from the Township online (ie: dog tags, drain charges, campground fees etc). Once you’ve created your account, simply log in and follow instructions.
- 2. There is a surcharge of 2.5% per credit transaction.
- 3. Payment options are by credit card or PayPal only.
